- ◆ crime-fighting initiatives and demonstrations by the Police Department
- ◆ extensive network of parks and recreation opportunities
- ◆ neighborhood improvement plans
- ◆ finance and budgeting coordination
- ◆ road/sidewalk maintenance and traffic management, plus much more.
